

Portrait with night scenery.
Hold the camera firmly and
the subject should keep still
for at least 1 second.


NIGHT SCENERY

For taking a picture with night scenery, Shutter will be set to max. 8sec. Be sure to use a tripod.




SNOW



Centre Weighted


